Daniel's Seventy Weeks Outlined Part III - God's Strange Work

Daniel 9:24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. Daniel 9:25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

Daniel 9:26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Daniel 9:27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

 - 1. It Only Concerns Daniel's People Jews
 - 2. It Only Concerns the Holy City Jerusalem
- B. The Purpose of the Vision of Seventy Weeks Six Points All Still Future
 - 1. To Finish the Transgression Ezekiel 39:24-25 (pesha) No More Israel Rebellion
 - 2. To Make an End of Sin Romans 11:25-29 (Law will be in Israel's Hearts)
 - 3. to Make Reconciliation for Iniquity Zechariah 12:9-14; 13:6-7 (Israel Reconciled)
 - 4. To Bring in Everlasting Righteousness Jer. 23:6 Christ ruling with Rod of Iron)
 - 5. To Seal up The Vision and Prophecy Joel 2:27-28
 - 6. To Anoint the Most Holy "Holy of Holies", Ko-desh (Ezekiel 43:2-5)

C. This is Israel's New Covenant

Jeremiah 31:33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Jeremiah 31:34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

- G. It will Seal up the Vision and Prophecy
 - 1. Israel's vision & prophecy appears to be sealed now

Romans 11:25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

- 2. At the Millennium there will be no need for Vision or Prophecy
 I Corinthians 13:8 Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away.
- 3. "That which is part will go" I Corinthians 13:9 For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. I Corinthians 13:10 But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.
- H. To Anoint the Most Holy Ko-desh Holy of Holies Millennial Temple Ezekiel 41-42

- 1. Some misinterpret & believe that the most holy means Christ
 - a. This would mean that anointing the most holy was Christ's baptism
 - b. Meant Christ's baptism in Holy Spirit at River Jordan
- 2. The Most Holy is a place not a person

06944 vdq qodesh KO'-desh - "holy" 262,"sanctuary" 68

- 3. This most holy place is the future Millennial Temple
 - a. The Shekinah Glory 1st appeared in Exodus 13:21-22
 - 1. It went before the Children of Israel in a Pillar of Cloud by day
 - 2. The Lord went before the Children of Israel in a Pillar of Fire by night
 - b. When the Tabernacle was erected
 - 1. The Shekinah Glory took possession of the Most Holy Place
 - 2. Between the Cherubim on the ark Exodus 40:34-35; 25:10-22; Numbers 7:89
 - c. When Solomon's Temple was dedicated
 - 1. The Shekinah filled the most holy place
 - 2. The priests could not stand to minister I Kings 8:10-11
 - d. Ezekiel saw the Shekinah leave & Go to heaven
 - 1. The house (temple) Ezekiel 9:3 2. Later Jerusalem Ezekiel 11:23
 - e. Ezekiel saw a vision of the millennial temple Ezekiel 43:1-6
 - 1. Of the Millennial Temple 2. The Shekinah returns from the east
- 4. So when the Millennial Temple is built
 - a. The Shekinah will return b. The Shekinah will anoint the Most Holy

So the time between the departure & return of the Shekinah Glory defines the length of the Times of the Gentiles

The 70 Weeks Did Not End With the 1st Advent as Some Claim

- But Continues Until the 2nd Advent - All Six Statements of the Purpose Are Still Future

Daniel 9:24 <u>Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people</u> and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

I. The "weeks", shabeem shabuah, "70 sevens" – Literally "seventy seven-ed" or "weeks of years" - Not Unusual – 70 seven-ed and context is "years" (Vs. 2)

Genesis 29:27 <u>Fulfil her week</u>, (*shabuah*), and we will give thee this also for the service which thou shalt serve with me yet seven other years.

Numbers 14:33 And your children shall wander in the wilderness forty years, and bear your whoredoms, until your carcases be wasted in the wilderness.

Numbers 14:34 After the number of the days in which ye searched the land, <u>even forty days, each day for a year</u>, shall ye bear your iniquities, even forty years, and ye shall know my breach of promise.

- II. So during the first 69 weeks (483 years) three things will occur:
 - 1.) From the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem
 - 2.) Unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks
 - 3.) The street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

Daniel 9:25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

A. A decree will go out to restore and to rebuild Jerusalem. - There were actually 4 decrees, only 1 to "rebuild Jerusalem" - rest to rebuild the Temple:

- 1. Artaxerxes Longimanus' decree, the only decree to rebuild the city Nehemiah 2
- 2. That marked the end of the Babylonian Captivity and the beginning of the "70 Weeks"
- A. The street and walls of Jerusalem will be re-built in times of great persecution
- B. "Messiah the Prince" will ride a donkey into Jerusalem: Zechariah 9:9 Luke Develops
 - 1. People rejoiced but Pharisees missed reason for this event even though it was prophesied

Luke 19:39 And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him, Master, rebuke thy disciples.

Luke 19:40 And he answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.

2. They did not realize this was their Day!

Luke 19:41 And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it, Luke 19:42 Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes.

3. Prophesy concerning the Temple

Luke 19:43 For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side,

Luke 19:44 And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.

4. Jesus calls the Temple My House - Before Israel was under judgment

Luke 19:45 And he went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought;

Luke 19:46 Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.

Luke 19:47 And he taught daily in the temple. But the chief priests and the scribes and the chief of the people sought to destroy him,

Luke 19:48 And could not find what they might do: for all the people were very attentive to hear him.

Daniel 9:26 And <u>after</u> threescore and two weeks shall <u>Messiah be cut off, but not for himself</u>: and the <u>people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary</u>; and <u>the end thereof shall</u> be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

B. So after the 69 weeks (483 years) – Three Things Occur

- Messiah will be Cut Off, but not for Himself
- People of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary
- End thereof shall be with a flood, unto the end of the war desolations are determined

1. Shall Messiah be Cut Off- But not for Himself

Isaiah 53:3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

Isaiah 53:4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

Isaiah 53:5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Isaiah 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Isaiah 53:7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. Isaiah 53:8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? For he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

2. People of the prince that shall come destroys the city and sanctuary

- 1. There are two "princes" talked about in these Passages, Messiah, the Prince, and the prince that shall come. The prince that shall come has not come yet!
- 2. Who are the people of the prince that shall come? Romans Destroyed the Temple in AD 70
- 3. The prince that shall come is the antichrist Daniel's beast, John's beast, etc.
- 4. The revived Roman Empire people are the people of the prince that shall come
- 5. The antichrist will be a Roman
- 6. Desolations The temple was destroyed by Roman General Titus Still no temple today.
- 7. A few years later the Jews were scattered all around the globe

C. The prince that shall come, shall Confirm the Covenant for 1 Week - <u>Not</u> Antiochus Epiphanies

Daniel 9:27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

- He The pronoun for the noun "Prince that shall come" during the last week
- He will confirm the Covenant Antiochus Epiphanes did not do this
- Cause the sacrifice and oblation to cease- Obviously part of the agreement
- Overspread the Second Abomination of Desolation explained by Christ Matthew 24:15
- ❖ Temple desolations determined will be poured Revelation 16:10-11
- ❖ Daniel 8:25 By peace shall destroy many -
- **❖** Daniel 11:21 Come in peaceably and obtain the kingdom by flatteries

1.) What is known about "prince that shall come" and Abomination?

- a. He Confirms the Covenant with the Many (Concerning the sacrifices) Daniel 9:27
- b. 2nd Abomination of Desolation Matthew 24:15 To the Consummation
- c. More info about this Second Abomination of Desolation

II Thessalonians 2:4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.

II Thessalonians 2:5 Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?

II Thessalonians 2:6 And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.

II Thessalonians 2:7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.

II Thessalonians 2:8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:

II Thessalonians 2:9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,

II Thessalonians 2:10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

d. The prince that shall come will be utterly destroyed at the Second Advent

Revelation 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

e. What does God think about the "Confirmation of the Covenant by the Antichrist?

Isaiah 28:13 But the word of the LORD was unto them precept upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little; that they might go, and fall backward, and be broken, and snared, and taken.

Isaiah 28:14 Wherefore hear the word of the LORD, ye scornful men, that rule this people which is in Jerusalem.

Isaiah 28:15 Because ye have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves:

Isaiah 28:16 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste. Isaiah 28:17 Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place.

Isaiah 28:18 And your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it.

Isaiah 28:19 From the time that it goeth forth it shall take you: for morning by morning shall it pass over, by day and by night: and it shall be a vexation only to understand the report. Isaiah 28:20 For the bed is shorter than that a man can stretch himself on it: and the covering narrower than that he can wrap himself in it.

Isaiah 28:21 For the LORD shall rise up as in mount Perazim, he shall be wroth as in the valley of Gibeon, that he may do his work, his strange work; and bring to pass his act, his strange act. Isaiah 28:22 Now therefore be ye not mockers, lest your bands be made strong: for I have heard from the Lord GOD of hosts a consumption, even determined upon the whole earth. Isaiah 28:23 Give ye ear, and hear my voice; hearken, and hear my speech.

2.) Temple Destruction and Dispersion from Rejecting the Messiah

- a. Parable of Householder and wicked husbandman. The Householder improved His property with a vineyard etc., and let it out to a husbandman while the Householder went into a far country. When harvest time came, He sent servants, whom the husbandman killed. The Householder then sent His Son to the Vineyard:
 - b. What did the husbandman do to the Son?

Matthew 21:38 But when the husbandmen saw the son, they said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and let us seize on his inheritance.

Matthew 21:39 And they caught him, and cast him out of the vineyard, and slew him...

Matthew 21:40 When the lord therefore of the vineyard cometh, what will he do unto those husbandmen?

Matthew 21:41 They say unto him, He will miserably destroy those wicked men, and will let out his vineyard unto other husbandmen, which shall render him the fruits in their seasons.

Matthew 21:42 Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?

Matthew 21:43 Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof.

Matthew 21:44 And whosoever shall fall on this stone shall be broken: but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.

Matthew 21:45 And when the chief priests and Pharisees had heard his parables, they perceived that he spake of them.

Matthew 21:46 But when they sought to lay hands on him, they feared the multitude, because they took him for a prophet.

c. Romans were just doing God's bidding - As Nebuchadnezzar did

Parable of the Marriage Feast - The Kingdom of Heaven is like a King that held a big feast for His Son's wedding, but the guests made light of it and killed the King's servants. The King then took his armies and destroyed them and told His servants:

Matthew 22:9 Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage.

Matthew 22:10 So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, both bad and good: and the wedding was furnished with guests.

Matthew 22:11 And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment:

Matthew 22:12 And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless.

Matthew 22:13 Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 22:14 For many are called, but few are chosen.

d. Daniel 9:27 ... and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate."

Revelation 16:10 And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain,

Revelation 16:11 And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.

e. Desolations will be determined - Your House is left unto you Desolate -

Matthew 23:33 Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell? Matthew 23:34 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them ye shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city:

Matthew 23:35 That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.

Matthew 23:36 Verily I say unto you, All these things shall come upon this generation.

Matthew 23:37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!

Matthew 23:38 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate.

Matthew 23:39 For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.

f. Israel will be many days without national identity

Hosea 3:4 For the children of Israel shall abide many days without a king, and without a prince, and without an image, and without an ephod, and without teraphim:

g. Does God say He will not be their God?

Hosea 1:2 The beginning of the word of the LORD by Hosea. And the LORD said to Hosea, Go, take unto thee a wife of whoredoms and children of whoredoms: for the land hath committed great whoredom, departing from the LORD.

Hosea 1:3 So he went and took Gomer the daughter of Diblaim; which conceived, and bare him a

Hosea 1:4 And the LORD said unto him, Call his name Jezreel; for yet a little while, and I will avenge the blood of Jezreel upon the house of Jehu, and will cause to cease the kingdom of the house of Israel.

Hosea 1:5 And it shall come to pass at that day, that I will break the bow of Israel in the valley of Jezreel.-

Hosea 1:6 And she conceived again, and bare a daughter. And God said unto him, Call her name Loruhamah: for I will no more have mercy upon the house of Israel; but I will utterly take them away.

Hosea 1:7 But I will have mercy upon the house of Judah, and will save them by the LORD their God, and will not save them by bow, nor by sword, nor by battle, by horses, nor by horsemen. Hosea 1:8 Now when she had weaned Loruhamah, she conceived, and bare a son.

Hosea 1:9 Then said God, Call his name Loammi: for ye are not my people, and I will not be your God.

Hosea 1:10 Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered; and it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people, there it shall be said unto them, Ye are the sons of the living God. Hosea 1:11 Then shall the children of Judah and the children of Israel be gathered together, and appoint themselves one head, and they shall come up out of the land: for great shall be the day of Jezreel.

h. Made a Covenant with Hell, But the Nation of Israel will be saved by the Stone – Like Nebo's dream – God's Judgment is His Strange Work

i. But first the Lord will Make Israel Jealous - Like Householder's Vineyard Parable

Deuteronomy 32:18 Of the Rock that begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee.

Deuteronomy 32:19 And when the LORD saw it, he abhorred them, because of the provoking of his sons, and of his daughters.

Deuteronomy 32:20 And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no faith.

Deuteronomy 32:21 They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with those which are not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.

j. The Lord Judges Righteously – Paul expounds and quotes Old Testament-Hosea, Isaiah

Romans 9:18 Therefore hath he mercy on whom he will have mercy, and whom he will he hardeneth.

Romans 9:19 Thou wilt say then unto me, Why doth he yet find fault? For who hath resisted his will?

Romans 9:20 Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to him that formed it, Why hast thou made me thus?

Romans 9:21 Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

Romans 9:22 What if God, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction:

Romans 9:23 And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory,

Romans 9:24 Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

Romans 9:25 As he saith also in Osee, I will call them my people, which were not my people; and her beloved, which was not beloved.

Romans 9:26 And it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people; there shall they be called the children of the living God.

Romans 9:27 Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved:

Romans 9:28 For he will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth.

Romans 9:29 And as Esaias said before, Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha.

Romans 9:30 What shall we say then? That the Gentiles, which followed not after righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness which is of faith.

Romans 9:31 But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness.

Romans 9:32 Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone;

Romans 9:33 As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

k. The Lord Has Not Forgotten Israel – Has blinded them, but All Israel shall be saved

1. Prophesied in the Old Testament

Isaiah 29:10 For the LORD hath poured out upon you the spirit of deep sleep, and hath closed your eyes: the prophets and your rulers, the seers hath he covered.

2. Fully Explained in the New Testament

Romans 11:1 I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin.

Romans 11:2 God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying,

Romans 11:3 Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life.

Romans 11:4 But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal.

Romans 11:5 Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace.

Romans 11:6 And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.

Romans 11:7 What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded

Romans 11:8 (According as it is written, God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day.

Romans 11:9 And David saith, Let their table be made a snare, and a trap, and a stumblingblock, and a recompence unto them:

Romans 11:10 Let their eyes be darkened, that they may not see, and bow down their back alway.

Romans 11:11 I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but rather through their fall salvation is come unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy.

Romans 11:12 Now if the fall of them be the riches of the world, and the diminishing of them the riches of the Gentiles; how much more their fulness?

Romans 11:13 For I speak to you Gentiles, inasmuch as I am the apostle of the Gentiles, I magnify mine office:

Romans 11:14 If by any means I may provoke to emulation them which are my flesh, and might save some of them.

Romans 11:15 For if the casting away of them be the reconciling of the world, what shall the receiving of them be, but life from the dead?

Romans 11:16 For if the firstfruit be holy, the lump is also holy: and if the root be holy, so are the branches.

Romans 11:17 And if some of the branches be broken off, and thou, being a wild olive tree, wert graffed in among them, and with them partakest of the root and fatness of the olive tree; Romans 11:18 Boast not against the branches. But if thou boast, thou bearest not the root, but

Romans 11:19 Thou wilt say then, The branches were broken off, that I might be graffed in.

Romans 11:20 Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear:

Romans 11:21 For if God spared not the natural branches, take heed lest he also spare not thee.

Romans 11:22 Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in his goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off.

Romans 11:23 And they also, if they abide not still in unbelief, shall be graffed in: for God is able to graff them in again.

Romans 11:24 For if thou wert cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and wert graffed contrary to nature into a good olive tree: how much more shall these, which be the natural branches, be graffed into their own olive tree?

3. After the slumber, All Israel will be saved:

Romans 11:25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

Romans 11:26 And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:

Romans 11:27 For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.

4. The Depth and Riches God

Romans 11:32 For God hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all. Romans 11:33 Of the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out!

Romans 11:34 For who hath known the mind of the Lord? or who hath been his counsellor?

3.) And in Amos

Amos 9:14 And I will bring again the captivity of my people of Israel, and they shall build the waste cities, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and drink the wine thereof; they shall also make gardens, and eat the fruit of them.

Amos 9:15 And I will plant them upon their land, and they shall no more be pulled up out of their land which I have given them, saith the LORD thy God.

4.) Micah

Micah 7:15 According to the days of thy coming out of the land of Egypt will I shew unto him marvellous things.

Micah 7:16 The nations shall see and be confounded at all their might: they shall lay their hand upon their mouth, their ears shall be deaf.

Micah 7:17 They shall lick the dust like a serpent, they shall move out of their holes like worms of the earth: they shall be afraid of the LORD our God, and shall fear because of thee.

Micah 7:18 Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy.

Micah 7:19 He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.

Micah 7:20 Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.
